

# **Guidelines and Procedure for Admission to Higher Secondary (Arts & Science) Academic Session: 2026–27**

As per the directives of the Government of Assam and the Assam State School Education Board (ASSEB) admission to the Higher Secondary (HS) First Year in Arts and Science streams at Abhayapuri College, Abhayapuri shall be conducted through the DARPAN Admission Portal. The following procedure and guidelines are to be strictly followed by all applicants.

## **1. Mode of Admission**

Admission to Higher Secondary First Year (Arts & Science) will be conducted only through the DARPAN Online Admission Portal of the Government of Assam.

Applicants must apply online through the portal within the time period notified by the authority.

Admission will be processed strictly according to:

- Merit basis
- Reservation rules of Government of Assam
- DARPAN portal guidelines
- Availability of seats in the respective stream

## **2. Courses/Streams Offered**

Abhayapuri College offers admission in the following courses/streams:

- i. Arts Stream
- ii. Science Stream

Applicants must select their preferred stream during the online application on the DARPAN portal.

## **3. Minimum Cut-Off Marks for Eligibility**

The minimum percentage of marks required in the HSLC Examination (or equivalent) for eligibility are as follows:

### **A. Science Stream**

Category	Minimum % Required
General Category	60%
Reserved Category (SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/Tea Tribe/EWS etc.)	50%

Students securing marks below the above criteria will not be eligible for admission into the Science stream.

## B. Arts Stream

Category	Minimum % Required
General Category	45%
Reserved Category (SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/Tea Tribe/EWS etc.)	40%

Admission will be granted strictly on merit within the eligible applicants.

### 4. Uniform Policy

The college enforces strict adherence to the prescribed uniform irrespective of religion, caste, creed, or personal preference. Hence, students of Abhayapuri College must strictly adhere to the prescribed college uniform without exception. While on the college campus, every student shall set aside all religious, social, cultural, and personal identities and present themselves solely as students of Abhayapuri College. The uniform symbolizes equality, discipline, and unity within the academic community; therefore, no deviation or modification of the prescribed uniform will be permitted on the basis of religion, caste, creed, or personal preference. All students will be regarded and treated equally as members of the Abhayapuri College community, and strict compliance with the uniform policy is mandatory. All students admitted to Higher Secondary classes must strictly follow the College Uniform Policy.

### Important Instructions

1. Wearing the official college uniform is compulsory for all HS students.
2. No deviation from the uniform will be permitted on religious or personal grounds.
3. Students must wear the uniform during:
  - Regular classes
  - Examinations
  - Academic programmes
  - College events
4. Students violating the uniform rules may face disciplinary action.

### 5. Admission Through DARPAN Portal

Admission will be conducted strictly through the DARPAN Admission Portal of the Government of Assam.

Applicants must complete the following steps.

#### Step 1: Online Registration

Students must:

1. Visit the DARPAN admission portal.
2. Register using:
  - HSLC Roll Number
  - Mobile Number
  - Basic personal details.
3. Create login credentials.

## **Step 2: Filling Online Application**

After registration, the applicant must:

1. Fill in the application form carefully.
2. Select:
  - Abhayapuri College, Abhayapuri
  - Preferred stream (Arts or Science).
3. Upload required documents.
4. Submit the online application.

Students may select multiple institutions according to portal guidelines.

## **Step 3: Document Upload**

Applicants must upload the following documents in the portal:

- HSLC Marksheet
- HSLC Admit Card
- Caste Certificate (for reserved category)
- Passport size photograph
- Income Certificate (if applicable)
- Disability certificate (if applicable)

All documents must be clear and valid.

## **Step 4: Merit List Preparation**

The college will prepare the merit list automatically through the DARPAN portal based on:

- HSLC marks
- Category reservation
- Stream preference
- Seat availability

The merit list will be published in the DARPAN portal and College Notice Board/Website.

## **Step 5: Confirmation of Admission**

Students selected in the merit list must:

1. Log in to the DARPAN portal.
2. Confirm admission within the specified time.
3. Pay admission fees as prescribed.

Failure to confirm admission within the given time will lead to automatic cancellation of the seat.

## **6. Reservation Policy**



Reservation of seats will be implemented strictly as per Government of Assam reservation policy, including categories such as:

- SC
- ST (P)
- ST (H)
- OBC / MOBC
- Tea Tribe
- EWS
- PwD

Applicants claiming reservation must upload valid supporting documents.

#### 7. Important Instructions for Applicants

1. Admission dates will be strictly according to the notification issued by the DARPAN portal.
2. The college will not entertain any offline admission request.
3. Applicants must ensure all details entered in the portal are correct.
4. Any false information or forged document will lead to cancellation of admission.
5. The decision of the College Admission Committee shall be final in all matters related to admission.

#### 8. Verification of Documents

After admission confirmation, students may be required to appear in the college for physical verification of original documents.


Failure to produce original documents may result in cancellation of admission.

#### 9. Commencement of Classes

Classes for Higher Secondary First Year will commence as per the academic calendar issued by the college and Directorate of Secondary Education, Assam. Students are advised to attend classes regularly from the first day.
