Rules and Regulations for Spot Admission, Session 2026-27 **FYUGP (B.A./B.Sc./B.Voc.) First Year Admission** **Session: 2026-27**

The following rules and regulations shall be followed during the Spot Admission process scheduled on 15.06.2026, 16.06.2026, and 17.06.2026 for admission into the First Year of FYUGP (B.A./B.Sc./B.Voc.) for the Academic Session 2026-27.

1. The Spot Admission process will begin sharply at 10:00 AM on each admission day.
2. All candidates seeking admission must report to the admission venue (i.e. Hall North) before the admission process begins.
3. Before starting the admission process, the Admission Committee will announce:
 - a) The number of vacant seats available in each Major subject (with one Minor subject combination); and
 - b) The number of vacant seats available under the Two-Minor option.
4. Admissions will be conducted based on merit and order of reporting. Candidates must remain present at the venue when their subject and percentage range are announced. Candidates who report after the admission process for their subject and percentage range is over will not be considered, even if they have a higher percentage.
5. To ensure that no candidate misses the opportunity for admission, every announcement will be made three times before moving to the next stage.
6. Subjects will be called in alphabetical order, such as Arabic, Assamese, Botany, Chemistry, Economics, Education, English, Geography, etc.
7. When a subject is called:
 - a) The number of vacant seats in that subject will be announced.
 - b) Candidates will then be called according to the following percentage ranges:
 - i. Above 90%
 - ii. 80% to 90%
 - iii. 70% to 80%
 - iv. 60% to 70%
 - v. 50% to 60%
 - vi. 40% to 50%

Note: If two candidates with the same percentage compete for a single seat, the candidate securing higher marks in the concerned subject (Major/Minor) shall be given preference.

8. The minimum eligibility criteria are as follows:

Science Major

- Unreserved Category: Minimum 60%
- Reserved Category: Minimum 50%

Science Minor

- Minimum 40% for all categories

Arts Major

- Unreserved Category: Minimum 45%
- Reserved Category: Minimum 40%

Arts Minor

- No minimum percentage requirement

9. When a particular percentage range is announced, candidates must report before the Admission Committee with all original documents and photocopies for verification.
10. Document verification and allotment of seats will continue simultaneously until all vacant seats in the concerned subject are filled.
11. Once all vacant seats in a subject are filled, admissions for that subject will be closed, and the Committee will move to the next subject following the same procedure.
12. After completion of admissions under the Major category, admissions under the Two-Minor option will be conducted. In this case, candidates will be called according to percentage ranges instead of specific subjects, and admission will be granted based on eligibility, merit, and seat availability.
13. The decision of the Admission Committee regarding eligibility, document verification, and allotment of seats shall be final and binding on all candidates.

All members associated with the Spot Admission process are requested to strictly follow the above rules and regulations to ensure a smooth, transparent, and efficient admission process. Your cooperation and support in this regard are highly appreciated.
