ABHAYAPURI COLLEGE: A PROFILE



Abhayapuri College came to its existence on the 13th of August, 1955 as a result of the zeal and tireless endeavour of some great minds of the locality under the leadership of late Govinda Chandra Dev Sarma and the whole-hearted support of the local people. The residents of Abhayapuri, the headquarters of the then Bijni Raj Estate and the people of the adjoining areas were fired by the dream of having a centre of higher education in this backward region and they joined hands for the cause. Since then, Abhayapuri College has been at the service of the region shaping young minds and paving their way to the future.

Abhayapuri College is situated at the heart of Abhayapuri town, the headquarters of North Salmara Sub-Division of Bongaigaon district, Assam. Abhayapuri is a small town nestled amidst isolated hillocks and blessed with an abundance of scenic beauty and a serene and pristine environment. The town and its surrounding area is scattered with many historical monuments that are a reminder of a bygone era. Abhayapuri gets its name after Ranee Abhayeswari, the queen of the former Bijni Raj Estate.

Beginning its journey with only the Arts stream, Abhayapuri College came to be incorporated under deficit Grants-in-Aid system by Assam govt. in 1962. Later on the college also towards its goal of higher education in the region. **came under 2(f) and 12(b) recognitions by University Grants Commission (UGC).**

The Science stream, introduced in 1979, was also brought under the deficit Grants- in-Aid system in 1986 and with this the College took a Honours stride. At present the college has introduced the courses of UGC approved Vocational Degree Programmes in Information Technology (IT), Tourism and Travel Management (TTM) and Retail Management & Information Technology (RMIT).

It has been a fruitful but arduous journey for Abhayapuri College since last 7 decades. Due to the selfless and ardent efforts of the College authorities along with the co-operation of accomplished and dedicated teachers and office staff, students and the public of the locality, Abhayapuri College has been able to achieve its present prestigious position. It is a matter of pride that in the Golden Jubilee year of 2004 the College was assessed and accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with 'B' Grade during the first cycle of its inspection. In the year 2016, the college was again awarded 'B' grade (CGPA 2.50) by National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC) during its **2nd Cycle of inspection.** In 3rd cycle again awarded B++ grade with CGPA 2.87 by NAAC in 2023. In course of time Abhayapuri College has developed into an institution of excellence for higher learning.

Important Points to be noted:

1. Admission for FYUGP (Four-year Undergraduate Programme), FYIMP (Five-year Integrated Master Programme) and FYIPGP (Five-year Integrated Post Graduate Programme) either through non-CUET mode or CUET mode, will be provisioned only through the common admission portal (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>) for all Govt/ Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalaya/ Provincialized/ Govt. Model Colleges/ Autonomous Colleges. Additionally, admissions for FYIMP and FYUGP in State University campuses and Participating Private/ Venture/ Non-Government Colleges affiliated with State Universities and Assam University will also be provisioned only through the common admission portal. (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>)
2. Students will get six (6) options for program selection either in the same Higher Educational Institution (University/Colleges) or in different Higher Educational Institutions (HEI) (University/Colleges).
3. Students need to mark preferences against the options of programs. HEIs will be indicated of the preference given by the applicants. Autonomous Colleges /Universities shall prepare the merit lists in accordance with their admission rules. However, affiliated Colleges shall prepare their Merit list in accordance to the relevant policy of the concerned Affiliating Universities.
4. HEIs will have to do the academic scrutiny (selection of papers based on eligibility for the program/discipline) of verified marks after entering SAMARTH form number / CUET registration numbers.
5. After Academic Scrutiny, the HEIs will mark the students considered for offering admission by processing the merit list in the admission portal itself. Once marked and saved by the HEI, the merit list for the programs can be generated and visible to students in the "merit list section" of the admission portal (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>) After the lists are published in the admission.

6. The students will receive an admission offer message with a URL in their registered e mail and mobile number for further processing. Only upon acceptance of the admission offer by the applicant by logging into their admission portal, the Universities or Colleges will be able to process the application for grant of admission.

7. In the subsequent merit lists, if an admitted student is offered admission in a program/College in a relatively higher order of their preference, and if they wish to take admission in the other HEI then they need to raise a cancellation request on the first day of publication of the subsequent merit list till 5 P.M and the cancellation request will be automatically approved, so that the applicant may take admission easily. The fee will be refunded automatically, provided they make the payment through the Integrated Payment Gateway. In case the student has made the payment in cash then they need to collect the refund from the institution itself.

8. The total number of students in the Merit list against each program and discipline will be strictly as per the sanctioned seat matrix for the Major program in that discipline. In the case of Discipline Specific programs, the Merit list against that discipline-specific programme will be as per the sanctioned seat matrix for that discipline-specific programme. Once admission is offered by the College/University to candidates, it is mandatory for the HEIs to give admission to candidates subject to document scrutiny and in compliance with college/university policies, as applicable.

9. Waiting lists may be published by respective HEIs if they desire to do so. However, this is optional and if the students who appear in the waiting lists are not subsequently added in the next merit list, then the Department of Higher Education nor the SAMARTH team will be responsible.

10. Colleges and Universities will have the discretion to check and verify the Income certificates produced by applicants at the time of admission. In case of any doubt, the Institution may ask the candidate to produce further relevant documents to ascertain the validity of the claim regarding the status of income below 4 lakhs, and only after being fully satisfied with the authenticity of the claim, they are to be granted admission under the Fee Waiver category. If the Institution is unsatisfied with the claim, they need to inform the applicant in writing with justification and grant admission under the non-fee waiver category.

11. HEIs will be able to view their Fee status (received either through Cash or Payment gateway) and the net amount (admission minus cancellation) shall be remitted to the HEI's account upon completion of the cycle of admission 2026-27.

12. Transparency in admissions shall be ensured, including obtaining proper consent from students. Retention of original marksheets or certificates by any institution is strictly prohibited.

Students willing to come to college in two wheelers must have-

- ❖ Valid Vehicle Entry Card issued by the principal
- ❖ Valid Driving License
- ❖ Registration Card (RC) of the vehicle
- ❖ Header covered by helmet

Vehicle entry Card will be issued from the office of the principal on receipt of application in prescribed format. To get the formats, students must submit self-attested photo copies of valid Driving License and Registration Card (RC) of the vehicle.

EXAMINATION RULES

addition to the Final/End Semester Examinations conducted by the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council and Gauhati University for HS and Bachelor Degree classes respectively, students will have to appear in the Sessional Examinations/Unit Tests conducted by the Home Examination Board of the College as per instruction of the Council/GU. RULES FOR MAINTAINING DISCIPLINE



- It is compulsory for students to come to college dressed in the prescribed uniform and with their ID Cards displayed.

The Library being the hub of knowledge resource caters to the need of undergraduate students of B.A, B.Sc, B.Voc Courses and the esteemed faculty and staff of the college. The Library with its open access system provides an atmosphere for searching/borrowing the required books freely inside the library.

The Library is automated using SOUL 2.0 (Integrated Library Management Software-ILMS) developed by the INFLIBNET. The Library has the provision of OPAC-Information Kiosk machine for searching bibliographic details of books and to know the availability and non-availability of books. The library provides remote access facility of the digital resources of Institution (Institutional Repository) through college website (www.abhayapuricollege.ac.in).

The library has an impressive collection of books, journals magazines, newspapers, reports and bibliographic databases etc. The library also provides access to e-books and e-journals to the teachers and students of the college through Central Govt provided Scheme for country-wide access to scholarly research articles and journal publication in higher educational institutions ONOS (One nation One Subscription), N-LIST (Inflibnet) programme and NDLI (National Digital Library of India- IIT Kharagpur).

LIBRARY RULES & REGULATIONS:

Abhayapuri College Students' Union (ACSU) is a body of the Regular students of the students of the college and every student is member of this body. The office bearers are selected annually by the student through the Election to the students' Union held as per constitution of the union. The student union always extends cooperation to the college authority as well as the student to fulfill the objective of the College. It is to be noted here that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of the India has directed the implementation of the recommendation of the committee chaired by Sri JM Lyndoh (Retired Chief Election Commissioner of India) to form guideline on student election in college and Universities. some important directions of the Hon'ble court are summarized below.

- ❖ The entire election will be held between 6 to 8 weeks from the date of commencement of the academic session.
- ❖ The entire election process, starting from the date of filling of the nomination papers to the date of declaration of the results including the campaigning period, should not exceed 10 days.
- ❖ Only regular, full-time student of the college are eligible to contest the election.
- ❖ Student between the age of 17 and 22 years may contest election.
- ❖ In no event, the candidate should have any academics arrear in the year of contesting the election.
- ❖ **The candidate should have the minimum 75 percent attendance in classes.**
- ❖ The Candidate shall have only one opportunity to contest for the post of the office bearer of student union.
- ❖ **The maximum permitted expenditure of a candidate shall Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) only and each candidate shall have to submitted complete and certified accounts (to be certified by the candidate) to the college authority within two weeks of the declaration of the result. The election of the candidate will be nullified in the event of any excessive expenditure.**
- ❖ No candidate shall be allowed to make use of printed poster, pamphlet or any other printed materials for the propose of canvassing. Candidate may only use handmade poster at the place in the campus notified by the Election Board of the college in advance.
- ❖ The use of loudspeaker, vehicle and animal for the purpose of canvassing is prohibited.
- ❖ **Candidate shall be jointly responsible for ensuring the cleaning up of the polling area within 48 hours of the conclusion of polling.**
- ❖ Any complaint or inconvenience of the candidate or voters should be reported to the Grievance Redressal Cell of the college.

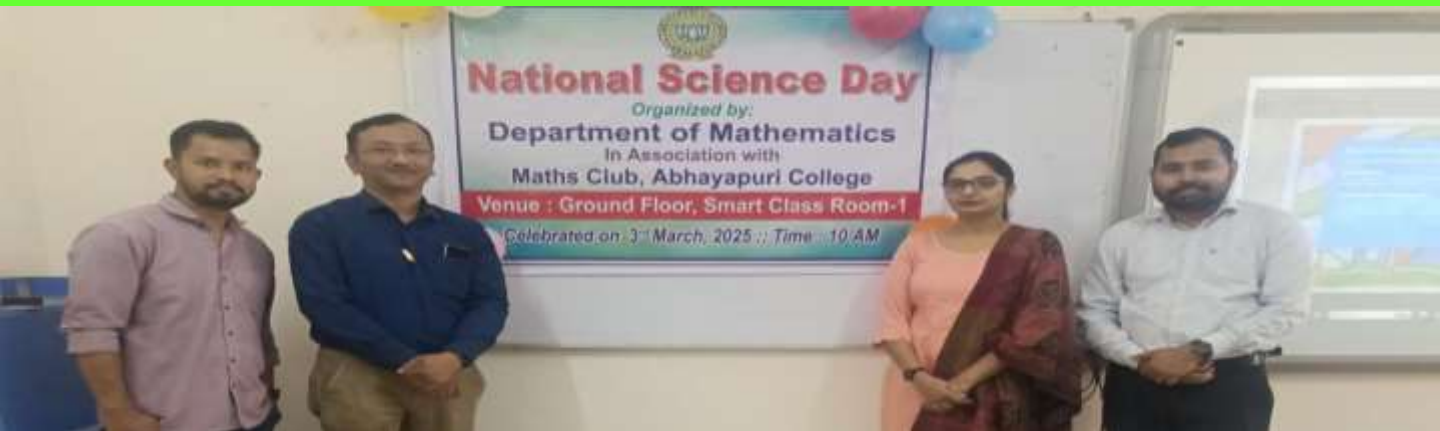

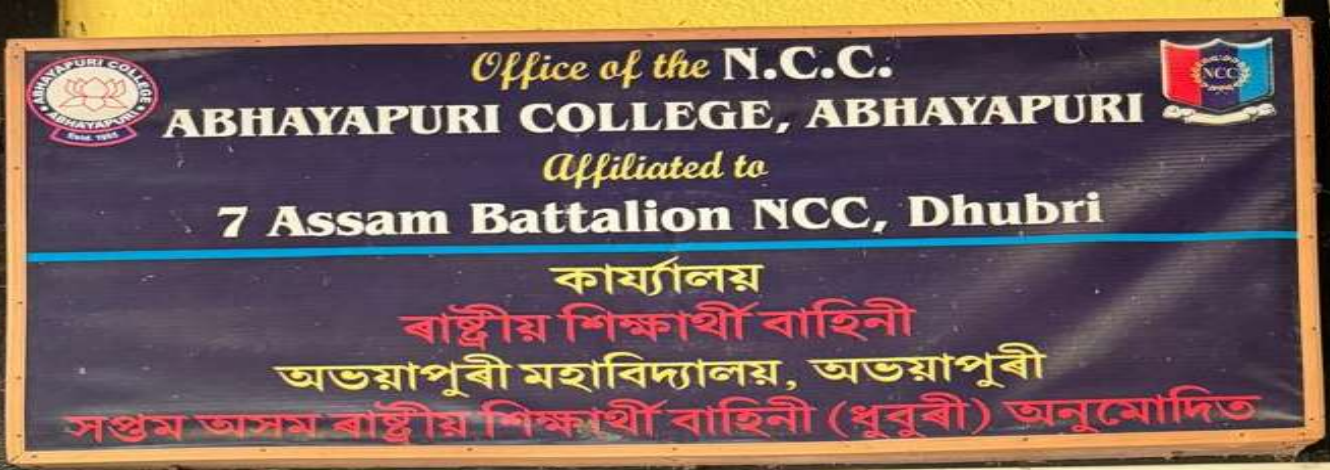

NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC)



Abhayapuri College NCC (Senior Division-Boys) was established in 1956 and since its inception the NCC unit of the college is rendering its noble service to the youth of this locality by providing training to make carrier in defence services. At present the college unit of NCC is running three years NCC course in 2+1 pattern

The Abhayapuri College NCC is working as Platoon under 7 Assam Battalion NCC, Dhubri (Assam) with an authorized strength of 75 Cadets of **Senior Division-Boys Cadets and Senior Wing-Girls Cadets**. Every year enrolment of new cadets in first year of NCC training is done just after fresh admission process of the college is over. Selection of the cadets is done as per the provisions of NCC Act' 1948 and related rules therein.

Abhayapuri College NCC Platoon has a glorious history. A number of cadets have participated in Republic Day parade camps,

(New Delhi) as well as National Integration Camps and All India Trekking Camps held at national level. Unit has participated in different social service activities like Blood donation, Tree Plantation, Anti-Drug abuse drive, AIDS Awareness programmes, Communal Harmony drive etc.

A number of present and ex-cadets have joined armed forces as their career. Students willing to take NCC course should have interest in NCC training and should be-

- physically fit to undergo the NCC training,
- studying in Abhayapuri College,
- in the age between 16 to 23 years

Thus, only the first-year students of UG courses of the college are eligible to take admission in NCC. Admission is given to regular students of the college on the basis of physical test organized by the Associate NCC Officer in presence of Permanent Instructor (PI) Staff from 7 Assam Battalion NCC, Dhubri (Assam).

of previous year, plus number of dropped out cadets, if any. However, total number of authorized strengths 75 is maintained. Of the total strength of cadets, 33 (thirty-three) percent vacancy is reserved for girls' students only.

Notification for new enrolment to NCC is done within one week after fresh admission to the college and the admission procedure starts thereafter. It is to mention that the admission to the NCC is done online through www.ncner.nic.in. Aspirants may contact Associate NCC Officer **Cap.(Dr.) Subrata Sarkar** or Senior NCC cadets.
