


Objectives



Topic of the Survey: A survey on the awareness about government schemes among the households of Bhomapara Village.

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS, Abhayapuri College and Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Bongaigaon Centre, have gone through couple of verbal communication to work together for the upliftment of the local communities in and around Abhayapuri town.

The main objective is to work together in making local community aware about different scheme and professions that KVK provides towards agriculture and animal husbandry in developing self employment. In these areas people may or may not be aware of the provisions that can motivate the youth in generating self employment.

As per its instruction of KVK Bongaigaon, to find out the number of potential unemployed youth who can be largely benefited by the schemes. Recently, the students of the department carried out the first phase of field survey in the Bhomapara village on 5th February 2021 with the objective to identify unemployed youth who can be benefited through different schemes available in the Kendra.

The survey was conducted in a questionnaire method for after 50 household in 25th February 2021. The household requested on socio-economic expect such as age, sex, family size, education of the family members, employment etc.

From the survey in Bhomapara village 6 youths have been identified having qualifications between metric and secondary and are dropout from school. They were also unaware of the provisions that KVK provides. The youths interaction were very interested to know more about the provisions of KVK as they were mainly interested in self employing themselves.

The report on the first phase of survey was submitted to Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Bongaigaon Centre for further action in providing training to the identified youths.

LIMITATIONS:

After the first phase of field survey, the survey was further collaborations with Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Bongaigaon had to be kept on hold because of pandemic.

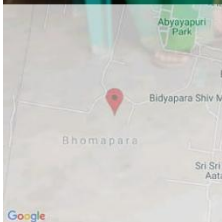

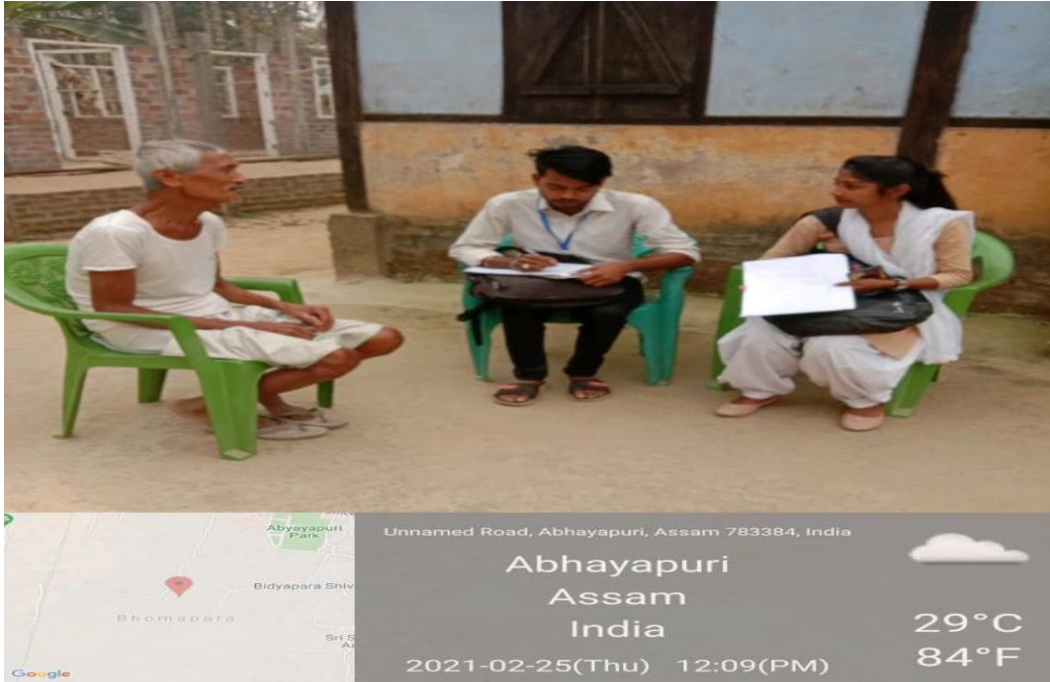

Topic of survey: A Study of product diversity in a rural weekly market

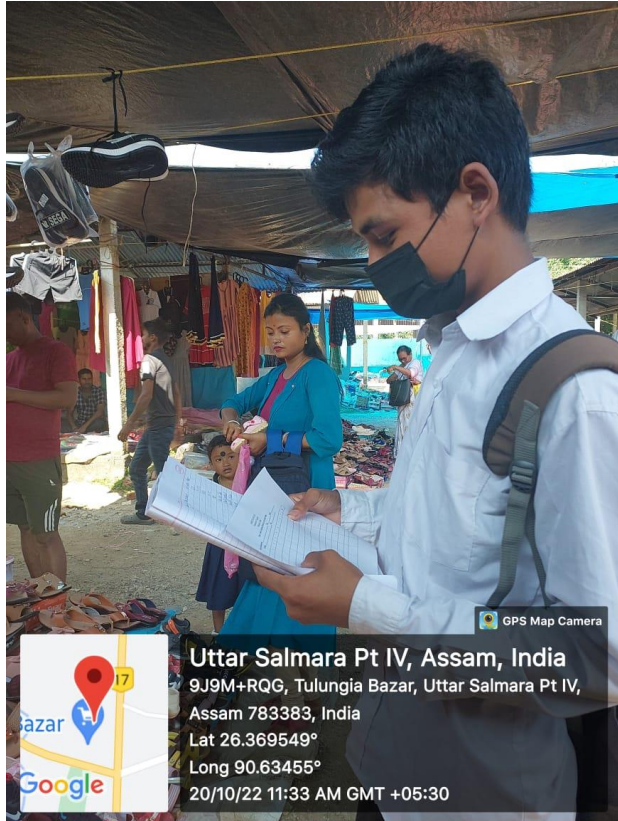
A field survey was conducted on 20th October 2022 in various parts Tulungia market by 3rd Semester students to study the product diversity in the rural market.





Date of visit:- 6th October to 11th October, 2022

Brief Report:-

The department of Botany has conducted its field study tour to Sikkim & Kalimpong, West Bengal from 7th October to 11th October 2022. Total 22 number of students of B.Sc First sem (Hons), 3rd sem (Hons) and 5th sem (Hons) along with teacher in-charge Dr. Subrata Sarkar (HoD), Dr. Ashoke Kumar Das, Trishna Roy Prodhani, Heena Rajbanshi of the Botany department. The team has visited different places of botanical interest in Gangtok and Pakyong of Sikkim. The team has visited the National Research Centre for Orchids (NRCO) on 8th October in Pakyong, where a seminar was conducted by the authorities of NRCO with special emphasis on Orchid diversity and their importance in North East India. Different species of orchid species preserved and cultivated in high tech orchidarium were observed by the students. On 9th October, the team has visited Nathula pass (Indo China border) and observed the high altitude vegetation of Sikkim Himalayan region. On 10th October, the team has visited Kalimpong hill station of Darjeeling district of West Bengal. In the road side of their visit, the students has collected different herbarium specimen.



Report of Field studies of the subject Environmental Studies


Field studies allow students to gain first-hand experience and knowledge of any kinds of environmental conditions. The scientific facts and principles become more realistic to students when they experience things more closely during field visits. Realizing the importance of field study in the subject Environmental Studies, Gauhati university makes field study compulsory for the students of 2nd semester irrespective of B.A, B.Sc, B.
