NSS Special Camp, Session 2019-2020 NSS, Abhayapuri College Unit Venue : Bhomapara L.P. School

The National Service Scheme (NSS) team of Abhayapuri College, a leading educational institution in Bongaigaon district, organized a week-long Special Camp (2019-2020) from 25 December 2021 to 31 December 2021 at Bhomapara Primary School this year. The camp ended successfully on December 31, 2021 with various activities. During the seven-day camp, the volunteers conduct yoga, sramdan, teaching to local children, various awareness meetings and trainings every day and at the end of the day, the volunteers meet with the villagers around the hearth in the evening. The first day of the camp, 25th December 2021, was inaugurated by the Vice-Principal of the college, Chintamani Deb Sharma, by hoisting the flag of the Rashtriya Seva Yojana. The event was attended by Professor Jayanta Bora, Program Officers, NSS unit, Dr. Nabajit Mazumdar, Dr. Pangkhi Hazarika, Bikram Ranjan Ray and former and current volunteers of the college. The volunteers then cleaned the road in front of the school. On the first day a lecture programme was conducted on "The Role of Youth in National Unity" was delivered by Mr. Dharma Ranjan Ray (journalist of 'Axomia Pritidin') and former volunteer of National Service Scheme unit of Abhayapuri College. The speaker highlighted the need for active participation of the youth in national integration with various examples. In the Evening cultural programme one of the best singer of the college Ajit Roy and Samarajyoti Das present there.

On the second day of the special camp, December 26, a lecture on "Women Empowerment" was held in the afternoon among other activities. The event was attended by Suriti Brahma Chowdhury (President of Women's Cell of Abhayapuri College and Senior Professor of Political Science Department) and Sarju Devi (Former Professor of Assamese Department of the college). Both the speakers had discussed on the need for women empowerment in the present time and the role of women in this regard. In the evening cultural programme was attended by actor Rupjyoti Das and former Rashtriya Seva Yojana volunteer singer Pallabi Roy. Actor Rupjyoti Das addressed the audience and volunteers about the stage setting.

On the third day of the camp, 27th December, an awareness program on "Environmental Conservation" was held from 2 pm along with various programs performed by the volunteers during the day. The lecture was attended by Dr. Ashok Kumar Das and Dr. Subrat Sarkar, Professors of Botany, Abhayapuri College as resource persons. Both the lecturers gave a theoretical discussion on environmental awareness. He discussed the precautions that the youth can take to avoid destroying the environment with information and examples through science and technology. Four flute players were present at evening cultural programme. The camp was also enjoyed by the violin performance of Jayant Bora, NSS Program Officer and Lecturer of English Department of the College.

On the fourth day of the special camp, the volunteers sang songs and held a program among the children of the school. In the afternoon, disaster management experts gave a training on

how to serve in an emergency time in front of the students and the people of Bhomapara. The trainers demonstrates how to help each other in the time of an accident or other emergency. The training camp was attended by resource persons Paresh Sharma and Utpal Bhuyan along with other members of disaster management authority. In the evening, Dr. Hitesh Das (Assistant Professor, Department of Mathematics Abhayapuri College) performed a beautiful program with songs and poems. Afterwards, the 108 medical service workers performed a beautiful musical programme.

On the fifth day of the camp, December 29, a cleaning program was held at the temple grounds in Bhomapara. Among other daily activities of the volunteers, a health awareness program was organized for the volunteers and villagers. The program was attended by Dr. Bhupen Vaishya, Director, Joint Directorate, Bongaigaon District, Dr. Munindra Kakati, Deputy Superintendent, Abhayapuri Public Health Center and Dr. Sajidul Islam, Paediatrician.
