The Outcome achieved so far are as follows:

- For introducing Computer Science in U.G. level, admission of students is going on. Enrolment of 07 students in the 1st semester has already been done.
- One class room for Computer Science has been constructed and the laboratory is set up for the same.
- The Career Counseling Cell has arranged programmes to provide counseling on placement of the students. Also, a campus recruitment programme was held, where 03 students were selected for placement.
- The Arabic Dept. organized an International Conference on 'Arabic and Islamic Studies in North East India' on 27/o6/2013 to 29/06/2013
- More students have been provided financial assistance from the Poor-Aid-Fund.
- The admission process has been computerized.
- The college has been able to hold more health awareness programmes.
- The internet facility has been extended to some extent.
- A sophisticated Xerox machine is installed in the office room.

PART-B

7. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution:-

The main objective of the college is to produce graduates fit for the modern competitive world. So, the college has been trying to make the students acquire different skills through different career oriented programmes. To impart extension education is also one of the important objectives of the college. The institution always encourages the students to participate in various sports and cultural events and extension works in and outside the college campus under the wings like NSS, NCC, EEC and Science Forum etc. It also imparts value education and education of civic responsibility for all-round development of the students. Thus the college has been working to achieve its ultimate goal of developing the society by imparting education in different fields in different modes.

During the year 2012-13, the college conducted 01 international conference, 06 other seminars, 01 community service related programmes, 01 health-related programmes and 02 Women Empowerment programme. The college has encouraged the faculty members to participate in different faculty development programmes and research works. This year 144 such programmes were attended by the faculty members. Again, 06 teachers have been pursuing their Ph.D. research.

So far as the infrastructure facility is concerned, the college has constructed 01 toilet for the teacher's common room and 01 shed over the generator set. The access to internet facility has been improved. 361 no. of books and necessary items have been added to the Central library. Besides, the college has conducted a number of programmes to inculcate value education and the sense of civic responsibility among the students.

Thus, the college has made endeavors to achieve its goals and objectives.

8. New academic programmes initiated (UG and PG):-

The college has decided to introduce Computer Science and Bio-Technology from the next academic year and has received necessary permission from G.U. to open Computer Science. It is hoped that G.U. will accord necessary permission to open Bio-Technology also in the next session.

D.El.Ed. (Diploma in Elementary Education) course under KKHSOU under Abhayapuri College Study Centre is opened from the session 2012-13. The course is

of two years duration and the enrollment of around 100 teacher candidates (TET qualified) deputed under SARBA SIKHYA ABHIYAN by the Govt. of Assam.

9. Innovations in curricular design and transaction:-

The college is affiliated to Gauhati University and it strictly follows the curriculum designed by the University. So, there is little scope of the college to take innovative role in curriculum design. However, the teachers offer necessary suggestion in this regard if the university seeks for.

4. Inter-disciplinary programmes started:-

The college has started interdisciplinary programme from the session 2011-12. However, realizing the need of exchanging knowledge of different disciplines among the students and teachers, the college arranges a number of interdepartmental seminars every year. Moreover, the Research, Publication and Faculty Improvement Committee have planed to hold a series of popular talk among the faculty members. However, no such programme has been held within this session (July2012-June 2013).

5. Examination reforms implemented:-

As the college is affiliated to G.U., so, it is bound to follow all the rules and regulations set by the university regarding examinations. So, there is no scope of the college to take part in reforming the examination system.

6. Candidates qualified: NET / SLET / GATE etc.:-

The college is an UG college; so there is no provision of appearing NET / SLET etc. from this college. However, a number of alumni / teachers of this college have qualified NET and SLET.

7. Initiative towards faculty development programme:-

The college always encourages its faculty members to develop their academic / professional career. So they are deputed to attend Refresher Course s/ Orientation Courses, granted study leave to prosecute their Ph.D./ M. Phil degrees as per UGC guidelines. Moreover, they are also encouraged to participate / present papers in different seminars / workshops / training programmes and undertake different Research Programmes.
